Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Ltd. (RVUN), a Government of Rajasthan Undertaking, is mainly engaged in the field of Generation of Electricity in the State of Rajasthan. It is presently operating (either directly or through its wholly owned subsidiary companies) the following power stations with installed/ planned capacity of **4368 MW** :-

Construction activities are going-on in full swing for erection of two Units each of 250 MW at the new Super Thermal Power Station at Chhabra. RVUN offers very good remuneration revised on the lines of Central 6th Pay Commission, apart from attractive Incentives and facilities, in comparison to similar Power Utilities in India.

Number of anticipated vacancies as indicated above may increase/ decrease at the discretion of RVUN, depending upon requirement and availability or non-availability of vacancies due to one or other reason(s). No notification will be issued for any such change.

Vacancies are reserved for candidates of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes/ Backward Classes (including the persons belonging to Special Backward Classes) category candidates of Non-creamy layer, Female, Widow and Physically Handicapped categories as per the relevant rules. Posts are separately reserved for SC/ST category candidates who are bonafide resident of Banswara District (Tribal Sub Plan Area) of Rajasthan.

2. Qualification (as on 17.3.2010) :-

Candidates must hold a Degree in Engineering or equivalent from a University established by Law in India or a Degree of a foreign University or institution, declared by the competent authority equivalent to a Degree in Engineering of a University established by Law in India, on the **17th March,**

2010. The Degree in Engineering must be with minimum 60% marks in aggregate or AMIE with minimum 55% marks in aggregate.

Provided that in case of Degree in Engineering, OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category candidates of Non-creamy layer will be allowed relaxation of 5% marks, and SC/ ST category and Physically Handicapped candidates will be allowed relaxation of 10% marks.

In case of AMIE qualification, candidates of SC, ST, OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category of Non-creamy layer and Physically Handicapped will be allowed relaxation of 5% in marks.

Candidates with the prescribed degree identified for the post as given below can only apply for the respective post:

Candidates must possess knowledge of 'Hindi' written in 'Devnagri script'.

3. Age (as on 17.3.2010) :-

The candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and must have not attained the age of 35 years as on **17th March, 2010.**

Provided that the maximum age for :

- male candidates of SC, ST, OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category of Non-creamy layer and female candidates of Unreserved category may be relaxed by 5 years.
- female candidates of SC, ST and OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category of Non-creamy layer may be relaxed by 10 years.
- Physically Handicapped candidates of Unreserved category, OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category of Non-creamy layer and SC/ ST category may be relaxed upto 10 years, 13 years and 15 years respectively.

NOTE:- The provision of age relaxation is non-cumulative i.e. relaxation may be claimed under any one provision, but relaxation admissible under any two clauses cannot be clubbed.

4. Reservation :-

Reserved category candidates should belong to one of the categories notified for the Rajasthan State as SC or ST or OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) of Non-creamy layer. Caste certificates issued in the prescribed format by the appropriate Competent Authority of **Rajasthan State only** will be considered as valid for availing the benefit of reservation, including relaxation in Application fee. Married Female candidates of SC and

ST Categories should produce caste certificate issued with the name & residence of their father/ mother and not with the name & residence of their husband.

OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category candidates of Non-creamy layer should produce certificates issued in the prescribed format by the appropriate Competent Authority of **Rajasthan State only** during the **last six (6) months** clearly indicating that they do not belong to the "Creamy Layer". The OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category Certificate of Non-creamy layer of a married female candidate must be based on the name, residence and income/wealth of her parents and not on the basis of the name, residence & income/wealth of her husband.

Candidates not fulfilling the above criteria should apply as "Unreserved" category candidates and should also submit Application fee accordingly.

5. Remuneration :-

Candidates selected will be initially engaged as "Probationer-Trainee" for a period of two (2) years and during the period of probation-training, they will be paid fixed remuneration at the rate of **Rs.10,000/- per month**. After successful completion of probation-training they will be fixed in the regular pay scale of Junior Engineer-I in **Running Pay Band of Rs. 9,300-34,800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 3,200/- i.e. at initial Basic pay of Rs. 12,500/-** & other allowances, including Generation based incentive, as per rules.

Facility of residential accommodation in the residential colonies of Company (subject to availability) and conveyance facility between the colony and Power Station may also be provided as per rules.

6. General Conditions :-

(1) A candidate who has more than two children on or after 1.6.2002 is not eligible for appointment, provided that the candidate having more than two children is not deemed to be disqualified for appointment so long as the number of children he/ she has on 1st June, 2002, does not increase. However, if a candidate has only one child from earlier delivery but more than one child are born out of a single subsequent delivery, the children so born are deemed to be one entity while counting the total number of children.

For this purpose, a child includes an adopted child or step child also.

(2) Married applicants are required to mention name of wife/ husband in the Application form and should also enclose "Marriage Registration Certificate" along with the application form. If the marriage is not registered, it is essential to submit an **affidavit** in support thereof.

However, if such candidate is called to appear for interview, then he/ she will have to produce the "Marriage Registration Certificate" in original, as the **affidavit** will not be considered as a valid document.

(3) Physical Disability means **disability of one arm or one leg**.

(4) In case of non-availability of requisite number of eligible and suitable female candidates of any particular category, such unfilled vacancies reserved for that category will be filled from amongst male candidates of the same category.

(5) Prescribed qualifications are the minimum requisite qualifications and mere possessing of the same does not entitle the candidates to be called for written exam/ personal interview. If more than the required number of candidates will be available, then candidates will be short-listed before calling for interview, commensurate with the number of vacancies under each category, by prescribing certain higher criteria.

(6) No TA/DA will be paid by the company to any candidate for appearing in the exam or interview.

(7) On appointment, all the candidates selected will be required to furnish a bond and surety in support thereof, as per rules.

(8) Initially for the first five years, all the candidates selected through this recruitment process, will be posted at the power stations/ projects of RVUN or its subsidiary companies, which includes only Suratgarh Super Thermal Power Station, Ramgarh Gas Thermal Power Project, Dholpur Gas Power Limited, Giral Lignite Power Limited, Chhabra Power Ltd., Kalisindh Super Thermal Power Project as well as Hydro Power Generating Stations situated at Banswara. Candidates so appointed will not be posted/ transferred at any other power station/ project or office of RVUN.

7. Application Fee :-

Unreserved category and OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category candidates should send 'Demand Draft of **Rs 100/-**' as non-refundable application fee and the SC/ ST and Physically Handicapped category candidates should send 'Demand Draft of **Rs. 50/-**', favoring **"Sr.AO(EA/Cash), RVUN, Jaipur", payable at 'Jaipur'**. The Demand Draft must be purchased on or after the date of opening of the Online Registration i.e. from **03/03/2010** to the date of close of the Online Registration i.e. upto **17/03/2010**.

Note:

- (i) As SC, ST & OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) Category candidates of other than Rajasthan State and all the OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) Category candidates of "Creamy Layer" are treated as "Unreserved Category Candidates", they should submit **Rs. 100/-** as Application fee.
- (ii) No other financial instrument like Cheque/ Money Order/ Postal Order/ Postal Stamp etc. is acceptable. Such applications will be rejected.
- (iii) Application once made will not be allowed to be withdrawn and application fee once paid will not be refunded in any circumstances, nor it can be held in reserve for any other recruitment or selection process.
- (iv) Printout of the system generated application, if not accompanied by the requisite fee will not be entertained.

8. Procedure of ONLINE application :-

All eligible candidates are required to apply "ONLINE" only on RVUN's website – www.rvunl.com on or before **17th March, 2010 (5.00 PM)**. The online Registration of applications will start on **3rd March, 2010 (10.00 AM)** and will remain operative till **17th March, 2010 (5.00 PM)**.

The system generated printout of the application form, alongwith Demand Draft and other documents as per the details given in this advertisement, should also be sent by post so as to reach on or before **26th March, 2010 (5.00 PM)** at the address given in this advertisement.

All candidates having registration in Manpower Planning Department, Rajasthan or Employment Exchanges are also required to apply through this procedure only.

Before proceeding for Online Application (i.e. registering application) on the website, candidates should possess the following :-

- (i) A **valid "E-mail ID"** for filling up the application form. In case, a candidate is already not having a valid E-mail ID, he/she can create a new E-mail ID, which should be valid for the entire duration of this recruitment process.
- (ii) A recent passport size colour photograph for affixing on the system generated printout of the application form.
- (iii) Demand Draft of **Rs 100/-** as non-refundable application fee for Unreserved and OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category candidates or **Rs. 50/-** for SC/ ST and Physically Handicapped category candidates, favoring **"Sr.AO(EA/Cash), RVUN, Jaipur", payable at 'Jaipur'**.

Name of the candidate and the system generated **"Registration Number"** should be clearly indicated at the back of the Demand Draft. The Demand Draft must be purchased on or after opening of the Online Registration i.e. from **03/03/2010** to the close of the Online Registration i.e. upto **17/03/2010**.

After filling the application form online, candidate is **required to 'SUBMIT' the application form**. If the application is accepted, the system will generate a unique **"Registration Number"** on the application form submitted by the candidate. The candidate will have to take a printout of the system generated online application form. This system generated printout of the application form should be duly signed by the candidate after affixing his/ her own colour photograph. One copy of the same must be retained by him/ her and the original printout should be sent at the specified address, alongwith following documents:-

- (i) The application fee in the form of Demand Draft for **Rs. 100/- (Rs. 50/- for SC/ST/ Physically Handicapped only)** favoring **"Sr.AO(EA/Cash), RVUN, Jaipur", payable at 'Jaipur'**.
- (ii) Copy of Certificate/ Mark-sheet of Secondary School Exams in which Date of Birth of the candidate is indicated.
- (iii) Copy of Degree & Certificates of all the engineering and other educational qualifications, alongwith Mark-sheets of all the years/ semesters.
If Grades are given instead of Marks, the "Grading-formula" should also be clearly indicated.
- (iv) Copy of certificate of SC or ST or OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category candidates of Non-creamy layer, as the case may be, issued by the concerned Competent Authority of Rajasthan State Only (if applicable).
- (v) In case of Physically Handicapped candidates, a copy of Medical certificate issued by the concerned Competent Authority.
- (vi) Candidate's own recent Passport size colour Photograph pasted at the given place and signed across on it as well as at other space provided in the application form.
- (vii) Copy of Marriage Registration Certificate issued by the concerned Competent Authority or Affidavit (if married).
- (viii) In case of a widow, copy of the death certificate of her husband.
- (ix) If a candidate is having any child, then an affidavit clearly indicating name and date of birth of all children, including adopted and step children.
- (x) Certificate issued by the concerned Competent Authority, if the SC/ST category candidate is a bonafide resident of Banswara (Rajasthan) TSP Area.

Note :-

- (i) Copies of all the certificates/ mark-sheets should be self-attested by the candidate.
- (ii) The printout of the system generated application form, alongwith documents mentioned above, should be sent by post in a closed envelope. - (iii) The system generated printout of the application form posted to any address other than the one mentioned above will be rejected.
- (iv) RVUN takes no responsibility for any delay in receipt of the Application or loss thereof in transit.

9. Selection Process :-

Eligible candidates will have to undergo a Written Competitive Examination, comprising of Objective Type Questions only. The standard and syllabus of the exam will be of the level of Graduation Degree in Engineering. The medium of the written exam will be "English" only. **The written exam will**

be of three (3) hours' duration and consist of 100 questions of the respective discipline. Minimum passing marks for Unreserved Category candidates shall be 35% marks and for SC, ST, OBC/BC (including the persons belonging to SBC) category candidates of Non-creamy layer, Female and Physically Handicapped candidates, this will be 25% marks.

The Written Competitive Exam will be held at "Jaipur", tentatively on the **18th April, 2010 (Sunday)**. Admission to the Written Competitive Exam will be on production of "Permission Letter", which could be downloaded only from the RVUN's website by the candidates. Permission Letter indicating Roll number, name of the Examination Center, etc. will be made available on the same website of RVUN in respect of candidates found apparently eligible based on the on-line data submitted by them and will not be sent by post.

A merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the written competitive exam and the list of candidates who will be called for interview, will be made available on RVUN's website www.rvunl.com. All short listed candidates will have to appear before the Selection Committee for adjudging suitability, Interview and verification of their testimonials. Final selection will be made by giving 80% weightage to the marks obtained in the Written Competitive Exam and remaining 20% weightage will be given to their performance in the Interview. Appointments shall be subject to final decision of the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court in the D.B. Civil Writ Petition (PIL) No. 12810/2009 – G.Sharma V/s State of Rajasthan. Final list of candidates to be sent "Offer of appointment" will be displayed on RVUN's website.

10. Other instructions :

- a. Before applying, **the candidate should ensure that he / she fulfills the eligibility criteria** and other conditions mentioned in this advertisement as well as on the web site www.rvunl.com. He/ she should also ensure that particulars submitted, are correct in all respect.
- b. Permission at all stages of the recruitment process will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility criteria and also presuming that all information submitted by the candidates are complete & correct. Verification of documents/ checking of eligibility criteria with reference to original documents as well as other terms & conditions will be done only at the time of interview.
- c. The eligibility will be determined on the last date prescribed for submission of on-line application i.e. **17th March, 2010**. Hence, all computations of age, requisite qualifications, etc. will be done with reference to this date only. The date of declaration of result / issuance of Mark sheet shall be deemed to be the date of acquiring the qualification. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- d. Candidature of a candidate is liable to be rejected automatically at any stage of recruitment process if any information provided by the candidate is found incomplete/incorrect/false or has suppressed any information/material fact or is not found in conformity with the eligibility criteria mentioned in the advertisement. If, at any time during recruitment or even after joining services by a candidate, any of such shortcomings is noticed, his/ her services are liable to be terminated without any notice.
- e. Candidature of a candidate is liable to be rejected if the System Generated Print-out of the application form is not received **or** received un-signed **or** received without his/ her photograph pasted at the given place **or** without Demand Draft of prescribed amount **or** without all requisite documents **or** received late i.e. after the **26th March, 2010 (5.00 PM)**.
- f. Candidates are advised to compulsorily enter the "E-mail ID" in the online application form, which should remain active/ valid during the entire recruitment process. No change in the E-mail ID will be allowed.

All future communications will be made through E-mail or RVUN's website.

- g. RVUN will not be responsible for any postal delay / loss in transit in submission of documents within the specified time. Similarly, RVUN will not be responsible for bouncing back of any e-mail sent to or by a candidate.
